



The One South Africa Movement: A Movement for Action

The One South Africa Movement is a community-based and activist-driven Non-Profit Organisation founded and led by Mmusi Maimane that seeks to unite a broad coalition of South Africans who want to see change in South Africa.

We exist to partner with South Africans from all walks of life – community associations, NGOs, religious bodies and business - to fight for the dignity and the needs of the excluded and the marginalized and in turn build a fair, more inclusive South Africa.

The Movement is the brainchild of Mmusi Maimane, former Leader of the Official Opposition in South Africa's Parliament, and is driven by the belief that South Africa can be a nation where citizens from all backgrounds can live as equal citizens and work to build a prosperous nation for all.

Having spent close to a decade in institutional politics, it became clear to Mmusi that the formalized political system is broken and self-serving, and real change requires action outside of the formal political system. This is why he has committed the coming years to champion and build the One South Africa Movement under the values of Activism, Advocacy and Accountability.

The Movement's founding principles are:

- To achieve broad consensus on a citizenship pact – founded on shared values - that commits all South Africans to active participation in building the future;
- To build and nurture a thriving movement focused on uniting South Africans from all walks of life and serving as a voice for diverse groupings of citizens from civil rights organizations, religious bodies, cultural groups, sports clubs and any other group or individual who identifies with our pact;
- To energize people into active participation in solving the challenges facing their communities; and
- To fight for those excluded and marginalized in society.

To date we have formally registered as a Non-Profit Company and established structures in all nine provinces. Our online and ground presence is growing daily, and our website is up and running at www.osa.org.za
